Student Satisfaction Survey Report

The students provide feedback regarding infrastructural facilities, library and other amenities provided by the college. A structural questionnaire containing questions regarding students views on facilities is used to get their impression and suggestions on relevant matters. In the academic year 2018-19 sixty four students participated in the feedback process. collected data has been analyzed and the report was discussed in IQAC meeting for further actions. The report is available on the college website. The students were asked about the coverage of syllabus in the class. The students replied that their 55-69% syllabus was covered . When asked about the teachers prepared for the classes, they replied that it was satisfactory. They were asked about the ability of teachers to communicate they replied that it was just satisfactory. The approach of teachers to teaching was very good according to the students. When asked about the fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers the students told that sometimes teachers were unfair also. The students told that sometimes the Institute takes active interest in promoting internships, student exchange programmes and field visits for the students. It was being told that mentoring process of the new comers is at moderate level. The mentors sometimes do a necessary follow up with an assigned task given to the students. The teachers partially identify the strengths and weaknesses of the students and help to overcome them . The students are being involved in continuous teaching and learning process. Students disagree that they are encouraged to participate in extra curricular activities'. About 50-60% teachers use ICT tools to improve teaching. Students are neutral about the teaching learning process of the Institute. Only few students participated in this survey. Institute is always trying to improve its level .

A questionnaire is prepared containing students views in regarding facilities provided to them in the Institute. The feedback is taken regarding infrastructural facilities , teaching learning process etc. Their suggestions and impressions are noted for improvement .In the academic year 2020-21 only 140 students participated in this survey. Their data was collected analyzed and the report was discussed in IQAC for further action. This report is available on the college website . Firstly the general information was collected about the students. The students were asked about their degrees. The students told that 85-100% syllabus was covered by the teachers. The teachers came very well prepared for their lectures. The communication skills of teachers was some time effective. The teachers were very good at teaching. All the teachers are very fair in internal evaluation process. Every time the performance is discussed with the students about the assignment. The Institute takes active interest in promoting internship, students exchange programs, field visit opportunities for students. The students were satisfied with the mentoring process in the institute to facilitate their cognitive social and emotional growth. The students strongly agree that institute provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow. Teachers every time inform the students about expected competencies ,course outcome and program outcome. The mentors of the students every time follow up with an assigned task given to the students. The teachers always illustrated the concepts through examples and application. Teachers always encourage the students to participate in extracurricular activities. Above 90% teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia etc while teaching. All the students were satisfied by the overall quality of teaching learning process in the Institute. The students suggested to update the library and they wanted some extra classes. Only 80%students filled the survey form and the Institute is always trying to improve its level.

SSS Report

The feedback is taken from the students about the infrastructure, library and other facilities provided to the students by the institute. A questionnaire containing the views of the students is prepared. It has all the impressions and suggestions of the students. In the academic year 2019-20 only 100 students participated in the survey. Data was collected, analyzed and the report was discussed in I.Q.A.C meeting for further actions. This report is available on the college website. The students were asked about the coverage of syllabus in classes in all subjects, the students told that about 70-84% syllabus was covered. The students told that the teachers came thoroughly prepared for the classes. When asked about the internal evaluation by the teachers, the students told that teachers were usually fair and they usually discussed about the performances of the students with them. The mentoring process in the institute facilitates the social and emotional growth of the students. The institute provides multiple opportunities for the students to learn and grow. The teachers encourage the students to work on their weaknesses. The teachers take pain to engage students in the monitoring, review and quality improvement of teaching learning process. Teachers fondly encourage the students to participate in extra curricular activities. Soft and life skills are moderately inculcated by the teachers. About 70-80% of teachers use ICT tools to make teaching effective. Students agreed that teaching learning process in the institute is very good. Some students suggested that the teachers should give guidance 1:1 on which Institute is making plans. Only 70% students participated in the survey.
